V) PARENT/CHILD COMMITMENT

A) Expectations of STAGE CREW

• STAGE CREW is a demanding club requiring punctuality, dependability, and honesty. We are "the show behind the show." Without us, performances don't happen. We need to be trusted by everyone who enters our auditorium.

• STAGE CREW does not have to be the only club you join, but you should try not to spread yourself too thin.

- You will not be required to work every show, but you should try to be available to work most events.
- If you play sports, it's advised to not work events during your season.
- Many events take place after school and sometimes on weekends.

• Some events take place during school, so it's expected that you'll need to maintain your grades at a high level (this is your #1 priority). If you do not, you will not be able to get out of class for an event.

• Continual lateness, misbehavior, and/or truancy will be grounds for dismissal from STAGE CREW.

B) Members of STAGE CREW may be dismissed for the following reasons:

- Repeated lateness/truancy
- Dishonesty
- Carelessness or immature behavior of any kind
- Misuse of equipment
- Inviting unauthorized personnel or persons into STAGE CREW areas when working
- Flagrant safety violations
- Sexual harassment
- Unauthorized access to auditorium

Consequences, such as suspensions or dismissals, will be doled out at the sole discretion of the STAGE CREW instructor based on the severity of the infraction.

C) In some cases, STAGE CREW members could be at risk of injury in the theater due to the physical nature of STAGE CREW. The jobs involved include...

1) Working with, cleaning, maintaining, and repairing electronic equipment and wiring.

2) Working with, cleaning, maintaining, and repairing sophisticated and extremely expensive theater equipment.

3) Setting up equipment in the auditorium and possibly other venues, such as the cafeteria, gym, and football field.

4) Moving heavy equipment and set pieces.

5) Operating, cleaning, and maintaining hand tools and power tools.

6) Walking on the catwalk (climbing ladders affixed to the auditorium wall to reach them) above the theater stage floor and auditorium house for the purpose of adjusting rigging and/or modifing/aligning lighting instruments or changing lamps.

7) Operating and maintaining stage rigging that has heavy weights on either end, including the raising and lowering of curtains/lights as well as the changing or moving of those curtains/lights, both with the vertical lift or from the catwalk.

* Jobs 4-7 have the most potential for possible injury

PLEASE BE AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) While this list attempts to be exhaustive in listing major jobs, it does not include minor items such as cable management, taping, sweeping, locking and unlocking cabinets, etc.
- 2) Before students do anything in the auditorium, they receive technical and safety training.
- 3) Students are reminded many times of proper safety and procedures when doing anything potentially injurious.
- 4) Any potentially injurious duty is always optional and never required.
- 5) Anything potentially injurious is always directly supervised by the auditorium manager.
- 6) As careful as we try to be, accidents can happen.
