Dress Code Policy Requirements	
Tops	<p>All tops must be solid in school colors with school logo:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Red Gray Black <p style="text-align: center;">Shirts must overlap pants.</p>
Bottoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Blue Denim Jeans or Pants (no rips or holes) Khaki pants or Khaki shorts (3 inches from knee; no rips or holes)
Outerwear	<p>Jackets and/or Sweaters must be solid in school colors with school logo:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Red Gray Black <p style="text-align: center;"><i>*Hoodies cannot be worn over the head in the building and classrooms*</i></p>
Shoe Wear	<p>All shoes must be closed toe with backing and/or back strap. NO Clogs, Flip Flops, Mules, Slides, Slippers, etc.</p>
IDs	<p>Student identification must be always worn and visible around the neck.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>No ID, No Hall Pass</i></p>
