Dress Code Policy Requirements	
<b>Tops</b>	<p>All tops must be solid in school colors with school logo:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> Red</li> <li> Gray</li> <li> Black</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Shirts must overlap pants.</b></p>
<b>Bottoms</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <b>Blue or Black</b> Denim Jeans or Pants (no rips or holes)</li> <li> <b>Khaki pants or Khaki shorts</b> (3 inches from knee; no rips or holes)</li> </ul>
<b>Outerwear</b>	<p>Jackets and/or Sweaters must be solid in school colors with school logo:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> Red</li> <li> Gray</li> <li> Black</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>*Hoodies cannot be worn over the head in the building and classrooms*</i></p>
<b>Shoe Wear</b>	<p>All shoes must be closed toe with backing and/or back strap. <b>NO Clogs, Flip Flops, Mules, Slides, Slippers, etc.</b></p>
<b>IDs</b>	<p>Student identification must be always worn and visible around the neck.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>No ID, No Hall Pass</i></p>
