You must complete and submit a FAFSA to apply for Federal Student Aid beginning October 1, 2022.

Your FSA ID is used to confirm your identity when accessing your financial aid information and electronically signing your federal student aid documents.

- Your driver's license number if you have one.
- Your Alien Registration Number if you are not a U.S. citizen
- 2019 federal tax information or tax returns (including IRS W-2 information) for yourself (and spouse if you are married) and for your parents if you are providing parental information.
- Information on savings, investments, and business and farm assets for yourself and your parents if you are providing parental information.
