



Calculating Student Grade 10 Point Rule



- Each nine-week period is worth 25% for a total of 100% at the end of the four nine weeks.
- Student must earn a total of 10 points for each course to pass.
- ➤ 5 points must come from the 3rd and 4th nine weeks.

Expectations for Graduation Highlights

GRADUATE ARRIVAL: 12:30 p.m.

- The processional march will begin promptly at 2:00 p.m. If you are late, you will lose your place in the entry march.
- Walk carefully and report to your seat.
- All graduates will remain standing for the Pledge of Allegiance and National Anthem. <u>All</u>
 Graduate boys must remove their caps and hold the cap with your left hand at your waist
 level. Everyone should wait until you are instructed to be seated.
- As your name is being read, cross the stage, take your diploma cover in your **LEFT HAND**, and shake hands with the principal with your **RIGHT HAND**. Face the camera and pose for your picture with the principal.
- Proceed to the next area where you will take your individual photo.
- You will return to your seat and remain standing until your entire row has returned. You will sit together as a row.
- Once all the graduates have been called, the principal will instruct all graduates to rise, officially
 declare you graduates, and instruct you to turn your tassel from right to left.
- DO NOT THROW THE CAPS IN THE AIR! This is a safety issue!
- The principal will make closing remarks.

University of Miami - General Building Policies

- 5 tickets per graduate
- All guests entering the venue must have a ticket! Only those ages 2 and under
- do not require one.
- General admission seating First come, first served
- Guests, graduates, faculty, and staff will be required to walk thru metal detectors and bag checking prior to entering the venue.
- The venue also reserves the right to reserve its own seats for special guests
- ❖ /Re-entry is not allowed
- No outside food or drink
- * We allow flowers to be brought in, but we will be selling flowers for all ceremonies
- Balloons and strollers need to be check-in at the VIP Lobby
- * We currently do not have any COVID-19 Policies (mask requirements, etc.)






Pay to Park-(Pay by Phone)

- All vehicles must be parked head-in only.
- You can pay to park using PayByPhone and will need to enter your vehicle's license plate during the payment process.
- Pre-paid parking links
- PayByPhone
 - ► Hourly \$2.00 plus 27 cents transaction fee
 - A parking session of 5-hours or more converts to all day parking \$10.00 plus 27 cents transaction fee
- Pay Station
 - Hourly \$2.00; no transaction fee
 - A parking session of 5-hours or more converts to all day parking \$10.00
